Why present at the world café

Dive into a creative whirlpool with World Café, where dialogue sparkles and collective brilliance emerges. It's a collaboration that melds diverse views into a display of ideas, ripe for harvesting. Presenters will have the opportunity to inspire colleagues and to portray new ways of addressing child sexual exploitation and abuse.

How to Prepare?

1. FAMILIARISE YOURSELF WITH THE FORMAT:

The World Café consists of several rounds of short presentations and discussions, where participants rotate the presenters' tables to cross-pollinate ideas and delve deeper into the topic.

2. PREPARE YOUR TOPIC & PRESENTATION:

Develop a concise and compelling presentation of your work that can be easily shared in a brief opening statement (no more than 3 minutes). Your goal is to spark curiosity and conversalon, not to cover all details.

3. PREPARE VISUAL AIDS:

Create visual aids **if needed**, such as slides or any other materials you can show in your personal electronic device. These should support your topic without overwhelming your audience. Keep visuals simple and engaging.

At the Café

1. QUESTIONS TO PONDER:

Prepare 1-2 thought-provoking questions related to your work that will encourage dialogue and reflection among participants.

2. HOW TO SHOWCASE YOUR KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCES:

Begin with a warm welcome and your brief opening statement. Display your visual aids if you're using any. Introduce your thought-provoking questions to kick-start the dialogue.

3. WRAP-UP EVERY ROUND WITHIN 10 MINUTES AND GREET NEXT VISITORS:

At the end of every round, wrap-up and greet next visitors and repeat the process. Summarize key insights from the discussions, document the outcomes.
