Why present at the World Café? Dive into a creative whirlpool with World Café, where dialogue sparkles and collective brilliance emerges. It's a collaboration that melds diverse views into a display of ideas ripe for harvesting. Presenters will have the opportunity to inspire colleagues and to portray new ways of addressing child sexual explotation



1. Familiarise yourself with the format:

The World Café consists of several rounds of short presentations and discussions, where participants rotate the presenters' tables to cross-pollinate ideas and delve deeper into the topic.



2. Prepare your topic & presentation:

Develop a concise and compelling presentation of your work that can be easily shared in a brief opening statement (no more than 3 minutes). Your goal is to spark curiosity and conversation, not to cover all details.



3. Prepare visual aids:

Create visual aids if needed, such as posters, handouts, or slides. These should support your topic without overwhelming your audience. Keep visuals simple and engaging.

4. Questions to ponder:

Prepare 1-2 thought-provoking questions related to your work that will encourage dialogue and reflection among participants.

5. How to showcase your knowledge and experiences:

Begin with a warm welcome and your brief opening statement. Display your visual aids if you're using any. Introduce your thought-provoking questions to kick-start the dialogue.

6. Wrap-up every round within 10 minutes and greet next visitors:

At the end of every round, wrap-up and greet next visitors and repeat the process. Summarise key insights from the discussions, document the outcomes.
